



TOOL // Liste de vérification pour l'exposé oral performance tâche

What is it used for?

This tool is used to observe the student's application of skills, following instruction in Interaction Expressions ("Bienvenue ..." "Je m'appelle ... / Mon nom est) .

How do you use it?

The teacher assigns one of the following performance tasks, based on student ability. Students prepare a written script, rehearse, and deliver it to the class or to a small group of students.

Your school has a buddy system to help new students feel welcome. You have volunteered to be a buddy for a new student. When you meet the new student, you need to greet the student, introduce yourself, ask the student's name and welcome him or her to the school.

You are a student host at your school's French Culture evening. Your job is to greet the guest speaker for the evening at the front door of the school and show the person to his or her seat on stage. When you meet the guest speaker, introduce yourself, ask his or her name, welcome the person to the school and lead him or her to the designated seat on stage.

The teacher uses the observation tool to capture a level of performance for each student, with space for comments.
