



TOOL // Classroom Participation Checkbric

What is it used for?

The tool allows the teacher to gather assessment data regarding student participation and involvement in French instruction.

How do you use?

The teacher has copies of the checkbric on a clipboard with student names in the left-hand column. The teacher can make quick notations using the \surd symbols to indicated the level of student performance. The boxes can accommodate two or three observations over time of student performance.
