



TOOL // Peer Evaluation

What is it used for?

This assessment tool is a worksheet that can be used during French class to provide peer feedback for a given task. This could be used for various activities including oral and written assignments.

How do you use it?

Each student is given one of the worksheets and are tasked with peer evaluating two of their classmates' work. This assessment is administered by providing written comments regarding the task being evaluated. The first question requires the evaluator to provide two positive comments for their peer. This is followed by providing one example or suggestion on how it could be improved going forward/next time. Finally, the evaluator provides general comments in the last section that may or may not be related to the already mentioned points. Furthermore, this gives the evaluator the opportunity to ask any questions that could help to clarify any questions or confusion that may arise.

How do you adapt it to other subjects and topics?

The assessment sheet can be used for any subject or topic in French. The subject line is left blank to allow the teacher to choose when he/she would like to use it. This form is useful for providing feedback during oral presentations, written work, or various types of projects. It is also simple enough that it could easily be filled out during or after a presentation, using point form or full sentences.
