

### Homerville Mapping Activity

ON your graph paper follow the instructions to draw a map of Homerville. Use a scale, a compass rose and a legend to explain things on your map.

1. The town of Homerville is a perfect square that measures 12 km x 12 km (use a scale ie 1 km equals 1 cm).
2. On three sides of the town is a forest and on the west side is a lake.
3. There is one major street in Homerville it runs through the middle of town from the east side to the west side. It is named Main Street.
4. Centre Street runs north to south and crosses Main Street in the middle.
5. There is a church on the north west corner of Main Street and Centre street.
6. Birch Street runs north and south along the lake.
7. Oak Street runs north and south along one of the forests.
8. Homerville Public school is located at the very east end of Centre Street.
9. Elm Street runs north and south in the middle between Birch Street and Centre Street.
10. The forest at the south end of Homerville is called Sherwood Forest.
11. At the south end of Elm Street is a store.

<p><b>Level 4 - 80 - 100%</b></p> <p>map is detailed, neat, complete and contains all or almost all of the features accurately placed</p> <p>compass rose, legend, scale are highly appropriate</p>	
<p><b>Level 3 - 70 - 79%</b></p> <p>map is generally detailed, neat and complete, contains most features accurately placed</p> <p>compass rose, legend, scale are generally appropriate</p>	
<p><b>Level 2 - 60 - 69%</b></p> <p>Map has some details, neatness varies, somewhat complete, contains at least half of the features accurately placed</p> <p>compass rose, legend, scale are simplistic and somewhat appropriate</p>	
<p><b>Level 1 - 50 - 59%</b></p> <p>Map has few details, is disorganized and unclear, incomplete, and contains few of the features accurately placed.</p> <p>compass rose, legend, scale are missing or inappropriate</p>
