



TOOL // Pre-Unit Self-Assessment: Fractions and Decimals

What is it used for?

A self-assessment continuum used for students to self-assess their comfort level with success criteria before a unit begins.

How do you use it?

The success criteria are discussed with students before a unit begins. Then, students use the continuum to indicate how comfortable they feel with the different criteria. After considering that data, the teacher may opt to spend more time on a particular part of the unit or work with small groups based on need.

How do you adapt it to other subjects and topics?

This could be used in any subject where the success criteria are presented to students prior to the unit commencing.
