



TOOL // Observation Log

What is it used for?

The tool allows the teacher to gather and record Observational data on student achievement of a specific expectation in a specific subject area.

How do you use it?

The teacher identifies the specific expectation that is being assessed in the top right box. In the left box the teacher records “Look Fors” that will guide the observations. In each of the three boxes the teacher records students’ names who demonstrate that level of achievement of the expectation. This tool is particularly good for observations during math problem solving or science explorations.


