



TOOL // Guided Reading Record

What is it used for?

The tool is used to record anecdotal observations during guided reading with students. It provides a structure for collecting a range of information on student reading.

How do you use it?

When teachers meet with the students, they have a copy of the recording sheet in either a duotang folder, a binder or on a clipboard. The title and level of the book for each group is recorded on the left side. The teacher may record the key teaching focus for each group under **Teaching Points and Notes**. Teachers can make quick jot notes regarding student demonstration of the learning goal.
