



TOOL // Primary Math Exit Slips

What is it used for?

The exit slips provide the teacher with an “at a glance” assessment for learning of a particular math lesson.

How do you use it?

The Exit slips ask the students to complete a short task that is reflective of the teaching/learning of the instructional period. The teacher can quickly look over and identify the students who have grasped the skill or concept, those who need more practice and those who need re-teaching.

How do you adapt it to other subjects and topics?

These slips can serve as a model for simplified exit slips for primary students in any skill area.
