



## **TOOL // Measurement Assessment Check-bric**

### **What is the tool?**

Grade 1 – Measurement Assessment Check-bric

### **What is it used for?**

The check-bric provides the teacher with a quick way to assess student understanding of measurement concepts during math exploration and activity times. The data can be used for both assessment for learning and assessment of learning.

### **How do you use it?**

The check-bric is kept on a clipboard and used when the teacher observes students working at different math centres, exploring concepts that relate to expectations in the Measurement strand.

The key skills and understandings are listed across the top, and student names are listed down the left side.

The teacher can make a quick assessment of student performance in relation to the desired outcomes, and record a level in the box. As well, there is space for anecdotal comments that may arise while observing a student.

This data collected with the check-bric is helpful for intervention support, extensions or re-teaching.
