What is the tool?

Accommodations Checklist

What is it used for?

The checklist lists all possible accommodations students may need to successfully complete an assessment.

How do you use it?

The sheet is attached to a child's assessment when accommodations are required for success. The teacher checks off the accommodations which have been put in place for a particular assessment.

The accommodations sheet is sent home along with the assessment. With this sheet, parents can see what types of support their child is receiving and can better understand the assessment.

How do you adapt it to other subjects and topics?

This tool can be used for any subject area.

Accommodation Sheet

The following accommodations have been provided in order for this task effectively.

to complete

- more time to complete work
- some choice in topic or format (form) for task
- quiet work area provided
- periodic breaks and/or opportunity for movement
- some choice on location within classroom to complete work
- opportunity to work with peer to clarify expectations
- prompting by teacher to stay on task
- questions read to student
- repetition of expectations/important information
- answers verbalised by student while teacher/peer scribes answers
- instructions/questions broken down into parts
- amount of work reduced
- 1:1 assistance given to complete task
- discuss vocabulary in simpler terms
- use of technology/calculator to complete task
- use of concrete materials/manipulatives/word bank to complete task
- allowed increased spacing of questions/answers on test paper
- highlighted question words or key vocabulary
